Introduction

How are grants applied for?

A group wishing to apply for a "Giving Back" sponsorship through the GMGT program must complete the application form available on our website (<u>www.theapprenticeshipfactory.com.au</u>) and submit in accordance with the guidelines by the closing date.

Eligibility (who can apply)

All applicants must:

- Be a Not-for-Profit community organization (i.e. not individuals)
- Include direct benefits to residents of the communities in the Goulburn Valley Region

Criteria

The application must show the benefits to the wider Goulburn Valley communities.

- A group can only obtain one round of funding each calendar year
- Maximum of \$5,000 per application can be granted.
- Applications which require the purchase of goods or equipment need to supply a quote with the application.
- GMGT reserves the right to co-brand or place appropriate signage on item/project funded, if applicable.
- The applicant must provide evidence that the funds have been used as per the application. (ie. digital high resolution photos)

Other

- All applicants will receive formal notification of the outcome of their application.
- GMGT's decision will be final and no discussion will be entered into.
- Successful applicants must attend a GMGT grants presentation to receive their grant.
